Having received lots of positive feedback we are planning to repeat this event in November 2023. See Save the Dates overleaf.





# **Magnificent May Fayre Success!**

Finally, thank you to the volunteers who helped on the day. We couldn't have done it without you (or the amazing sunshine)!






